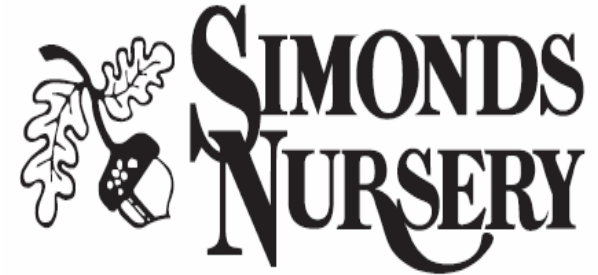

Simonds Nursery is conveniently located just minutes from I-795.

- From Reisterstown Road or I-795 take the Franklin Boulevard Exit (Exit 7B if northbound, Exit 7 if southbound), head west, and turn right onto Church Road. Go 1/2 mile to Berrymans Lane, and turn left. Look for Simonds Nursery on the left.
- From New Town, take Dolfield or Lyons Mill Roads West to Deer Park Road. Turn right and proceed 2 miles to Simonds Nursery on the Right.
- Coming from Route 26? Take either Wards Chapel or Deer Park Road. You will see Simonds Nursery at the corner on your right when you run into Berrymans Lane.

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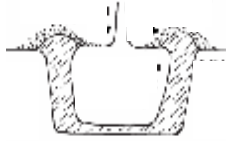
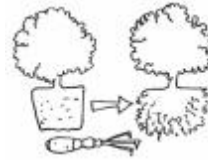

## Planting Guide

1. Dig the hole up to twice as wide as the root system of the plant.
2. Place the plant in the hole making sure that ½-1" of the root ball is above the existing ground level. Be sure any plastic container has been removed.
3. Loosen the root system to promote new root growth. If plant has burlap or wire cage on it please do not remove from under the root ball. Remove any rope, wire or burlap from around the top of root ball.



4. Fill the hole with mixture of 1/3 compost and 2/3 existing soil. Build a berm of excess soil at the outer edge of root ball to create a water ring. If properly built, the water will puddle around the plant 2-3" deep.

## Plant Warranty

The purpose of this warranty is to assure you, our valued customer, that our nursery stock is healthy and free from disease at time of purchase. Carefully monitor your landscape, and call with any questions you may have. *"We're here to help you grow"*

- Trees and shrubs are warranted for 50% of the purchased price and for 1 year from purchase date.
- Roses are warranted for 50% of the purchased price and 6 months from purchased date. We cannot replace roses that are not dead, but merely defoliated from disease, fungus or insect activity.
- Perennials and ground cover are warranted for 50% of the purchased price for 90 days from purchased date.
- Fruit trees and shrubs, herbs, annuals, bulbs, hanging baskets, houseplants and plants in above ground containers are excluded from warranty.

Plants are not warranted against extreme conditions such as but not limited to drought, ice, animals, insect, and disease.

Refunds will be credited in the same manner as purchased. Items purchased by check require a 14 day clearance.

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## Watering

When watering please use a water wand with a shower nozzle. When watering, fill the water ring up twice.



Always water the plant immediately after planting.

- ♦ 3 days the first week
- ♦ 2 days the second week
- ♦ 1 day a week for one full year.
